### **INCIDENT OR ACCIDENT REPORTING DUE TO BIRD STRIKES TO AIRCRAFTS**

The Civil Aviation Authority, through the Airports Coordination Area, informed the aircraft operators, pilots, ramp personnel and staff of the airport operator, the following provision.

Under provisions of "**Airport Services Manual / Part 3 "Bird Control and Reduction"**", "DOC 9137-AN/898 / 3.6 collaboration is requested in order to report any accident or incident caused by bird strikes or other wildlife to aircraft, on attached form.

This provision is mandatory, so that the government has information that shall be referred to ICAO. Forms must be requested and delivered to the airport operator, either in the administrative offices at the Airport Administration, or to the operations staff at airport ramp.
